Adara Hotel The 41-room Adara is that rare thing among wilderness hostleries: boutique accommodation with a modernist look. Located steps from the resort's shops and restaurants, the hotel is the brainchild of John Kuharchuk and Box Interior Design, who took traditional lodge elements—stone, timber, fire—and reinterpreted them in amusing ways: resin antlers in the lobby, exaggerated woodgrain laminates, ironic hologram fireplaces.
